

Parma Digital Papyrology Workshop 2022

Applications for the training workshop in Digital Greek Papyrology - that will be held from the 23rd to 27th of May 2022 at the University of Parma, Laboratorio informatico - are now open.

The workshop will be held in English and will focus on Digital Papyrology (Leiden+, Papyrological Editor) and Linguistic Annotation of Greek papyri. Basic knowledge of ancient Greek and of the conventions of papyrological critical editions is required, but no previous digital skills are needed, as the workshop will cover all the basis of Digital Papyrology.

Participants of all levels are welcome to the Workshop: BA, MA and PhD students, scholars, professors, and professionals may all apply. All participants will receive a participation certificate.

Please note that all participants will be required to bring their own laptop.

On **May 23rd** there will be an open Conference, both in presence and online, to which all applicants and selected participants are welcome and automatically registered: please specify if you would like to participate in person when sending your application.
